ORDINANCE NO. 01-20

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 2-151(a) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, SALUDA COUNTY, SOUTH CAROLINA, TO AMEND THE NUMBER OF YEAR TERMS OF THE SALUDA COUNTY AIRPORT COMMISSION

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 5-83, An Ordinance Creating the Saluda County Airport Commission; Providing for Their Number, Method of Selection and Terms of Office; Prescribing the Duties and Responsibilities of the Commission, was adopted by Saluda County on May 9, 1983. The Code of Ordinances Saluda County, South Carolina was adopted on April 11, 2005 and Ordinance No. 5-83 was codified in Chapter 2, Sections 2-151 through 2-153. Saluda County is now desirous of amending the number of year terms of the Saluda County Airport Commission from three year to five year terms as referenced in Chapter 2, Section 2-151(a).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY Saluda County that Section 2-151(a) of The Code of Ordinances, Saluda County, South Carolina, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2-151.

- (a) *Created; membership.* There is created the county airport commission which shall consist of five members to be appointed by the county council. Two members of the airport commission shall be initially appointed for terms of three years, and two shall be appointed for terms of two years, and one for a term of one year. Thereafter, all succeeding appointments shall be for a term of five years. No member of the airport commission shall serve more than two consecutive terms without rotating to an inactive status for at least one year before being appointed to the airport commission.
