#### A. CALL TO ORDER

#### D. APPROVAL OF AGENDA

#### F. NEW BUSINESS

On motion of Councilman Anderson, seconded by Vice-Chairman Atkinson it was unanimously approved to approve the additional repairs at the Courthouse and American Legion Building in the amount of \$183,890 to be funded from the Public Building Repair Account. Chairman Moore stated that this work had already been approved but the contractor had found additional damage and this needed to be brought up in a called meeting due to the contractor's time frame with court. Chairman Moore recognized John Oscar Perry, Maintenance Superintendent to present the repair request. The findings at the American Legion were that the old windows were rotting at the bottom due to the old sealant. The recommendation is to replace all of the windows with vinyl energy efficient windows and replace the rotten woodwork. The original bid, for the Courthouse was to repair four drains that were failing but the recommendation is to re-line all eight while the equipment and lift were in use. Councilman Bedenbaugh recommended using Tri-County for the dumpster and Mr. Perry said he would check into it.
