GUIDELINES FOR REQUESTING AN E911 ADDRESS

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Purpose

E911 addresses in Saluda County are assigned to ensure that emergency services are able to quickly identify and respond to a specific location in the event of an emergency situation. While this addressing system has been co-opted by the United States Postal Service and other delivery services, these functions are secondary to the emergency services purpose of the address.

Qualifications

In order for an E911 address to be assigned to a piece of property, the following criteria must be met to ensure that all addresses assigned are as accurately as possible:

1. The address must be requested by the property owner or person otherwise having legal responsibility for the property.
2. The property owner must indicate an intention to place a dwelling or other facility on the property within 90 calendar days of the request. If an address is assigned and construction does not begin within 90 calendar days, the property owner should notify the GIS & Addressing office so that the address can be revoked until such time as the facility is constructed.
3. The property owner must identify the location of the driveway, as E911 addresses are assigned based on the location of the driveway. In the event that the driveway is placed in a location more than 10 feet from the assigned address, the property owner must contact the GIS & Addressing office to ensure that the assigned address remains valid based on the new driveway location.

Process

E911 addresses may be requested via email, fax, or in person during normal business hours.

Property owner must:

1. Submit an "Application for New E911 Address."
2. Provide the location of the existing or proposed driveway.
3. Express an intent to build on or otherwise improve the property within 90 calendar days of the request.
