F. REPORTS OF COUNTY OFFICIALS

- 1. Coun. Grice and Vice-Chm. Daniel encouraged everyone to take proper precautions and to be mindful of others due to the seriousness of COVID-19 in the county, state, and country.
- 2. Vice-Chm. Daniel informed the public due to the increase in the number of COVID-19 cases in Saluda County, effective Wednesday, July 15th, the county offices would be closed to the public. Members of the public would need to make an appointment to visit County offices.
- 3. Vice-Chm. Daniel also reminded everyone to complete their Census 2020.

G. NEW BUSINESS

- 1. On motion of Coun. Grice, seconded by Coun. Butler, the School Resource Officer agreement between the County of Saluda and Saluda School District One was unanimously approved, and retroactive to July 1, 2020.
- 2. Vice-Chm. Daniel stated in the agenda package was a request to fill the Building Maintenance Worker position due to the upcoming retirement of the current maintenance worker.
 - On motion of Coun. Butler, seconded by Coun. Grice, it was unanimously approved to fill the vacant Building Maintenance Worker position according to County policy to be effective August 31, 2020.
- 3. On motion of Coun. Grice, seconded by Coun. Butler, it was unanimously approved to reappoint Tony Lake as the Hollywood Fire Department's representative to the Saluda County Fire Board with his second term expiring June 30, 2024.
- 4. On motion of Coun. Butler, seconded by Coun. Grice, it was unanimously approved to reappoint Brent Addy as the Mayson Fire Department's representative to the Saluda County Fire Board with his second term expiring June 30, 2024.
- 5. On motion of Coun. Butler, seconded by Coun. Grice, it was unanimously approved to appoint Jack B. Nichols of 441 Kempson Bridge Road, Saluda to the Saluda County Airport Commission with his first term expiring July 14, 2025.
