

NOTICE OF ELECTION Soil and Water Election

The Soil and Water Conservation District general election for the Soil and Water Commissioner is to be held Tuesday, November 8, 2022. Any necessary runoffs will be held on Tuesday, November 22, 2022.

The following office shall be included in this election:

Soil and Water Commissioner

Any person wishing to vote in this election must be registered no later than Friday, October 7, 2022. To register, contact the Saluda County Board of Voter Registration at 864-445-4500 # 2361 in front of Piedmont Technical College on Batesburg Highway during normal business hours Monday- Friday 8:30 am – 5:00 pm.

Voters will be asked to provide one of the following unexpired Photo IDs at their polling place.

- S.C. Driver's License
- ID Card issued by S.C. Department of Motor Vehicles
- S.C. Voter Registration Card with Photo
- Federal Military ID
- U.S. Passport

If you have one of these IDs, you are ready to vote. Voters should remember to bring one of these IDs with them to the polling place.

Citizens desiring to be candidates for the above listed office may file at the Saluda County Voter Registration Office, 702 Batesburg Hwy, Saluda, South Carolina. Books will be open for filing on June 27th, 2022, at 12:00 Noon and remain open during regular business hours until July 15th, 2021, at 12:00 Noon. Filers must submit a **complete** Petition to the local Voter Registration Office and submit a Statement of Economic Interest with the SC State Ethics Commission before filing ends. Candidates must be “ready to file” when entering the office.

This is a nonpartisan election, and no party affiliation shall be placed on the ballot.

On Friday, November 11, 2022, at 9 am at the Saluda County Voter Registration and Elections Office located at 702 Batesburg Hwy, Saluda, SC, the Saluda County Board of Registration and Elections will hold a hearing to determine the validity of ballots challenged in this election.

The polls shall open at 7:00 AM on Election Day and close at 7:00 PM.
