



PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTIONS

THE SOUTH CAROLINA DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE (SCDOR) DETERMINES WHETHER REAL OR PERSONAL PROPERTY QUALIFIES FOR EXEMPTION FROM AD VALOREM TAXES UNDER SOUTH CAROLINA CODE SECTION 12-37-220.

CERTAIN EXEMPTIONS MAY BE AVAILABLE FOR:

- DISABLED VETERANS
- INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE PERMANENTLY CONFINED TO A WHEELCHAIR
- INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE LEGALLY BLIND AS CERTIFIED BY A LICENSED PHYSICIAN

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS AND SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION APPLY. CONTACT THE COUNTY AUDITOR'S OFFICE OR THE SOUTH CAROLINA DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE FOR ADDITIONAL INFORMATION REGARDING QUALIFICATION AND APPLICATION PROCEDURES.

Property Tax Exemptions

The South Carolina Department of Revenue (SCDOR) determines whether real or personal property qualifies for exemption from ad valorem taxes under South Carolina Code **Section 12-37-220**.

Certain exemptions may be available for:

- Disabled Veterans
- Individuals who are permanently confined to a wheelchair
- Individuals who are legally blind as certified by a licensed physician

Eligibility requirements and supporting documentation apply.
