Proposals will be accepted until 3:00 p.m. on Thursday, June 6th, 2024 at the County Administration building located at 400 West Highland St. Saluda, SC 29138. Late proposals will not be accepted.

It will be the responsibility of the contractor to view the site to be aware of its condition. Incomplete proposals or proposals that do not conform to the requirements specified herein will not be considered. Issuance of the RFP does not obligate Saluda County to award a contract, nor is Saluda County liable for any costs incurred by the proposer in the preparation and submittal of proposals for the subject work. Saluda County retains the right to award all or parts of this contract to several offerors, to not select any offers, and/or to re-solicit proposals. The act of submitting a proposal is a declaration that the proposer has read the RFP and understands all the requirements and conditions.

SCOPE OF WORK

1. Finding and Identifying Water Intrusion

It will be the contractor's responsibility to view the sites and be aware of the extent of the damage to be repaired and determine where the water is coming into the building and how to stop the water from coming in. The site contact is John Oscar Perry and can be reached at 864-321-4388.

2. Stop Water Intrusion

The proposal must include detailed explanation of how the contractor plans to stop the water intrusion. The work must include a warranty and the details of the warranty are to be included in the proposal.

3. Repair Plaster Walls

The walls that have been damaged by the water are to be repaired and any details pertaining to the repairs are to be listed.

4. Paint

The damaged walls that are to be repaired are also to be painted to match existing walls

The Contractor must maintain proper insurance and workers compensation liability insurance though out the duration of the project and provide a copy of this insurance to the County.

All necessary permits are the responsibility of the contractor.

Proposals must include 3 referrals from other like businesses or entities that have had similar work performed by the contractor.
