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## **Saluda County Standard Driveway Specifications**

- \* All pipe must be SCDOT approved (concrete or plastic) no metal, cast iron, or clay pipes are allowed.
- \* 24 feet wide but no more than 32 feet wide unless approved by the County Roads & Bridges Superintendent. (*pre-approved pipe lengths 24', 28' & 32'*)
- \* A minimum of 1 foot of ground cover on the pipe which must include at least 6-inch thickness of SCDOT Spec. CR14 rock as a final top layer.
- \* One-man Rip Rap or prior approved suitable material to cover the inlet and outlet sides of the pipe for erosion control and headwall protection.
- \* Each access point shall be constructed in a manner that prevents water from flowing onto the roadway and from adversely affecting the existing storm drainage system. For example, driveways sloping down toward the roadway should have provisions for water to be intercepted off the right-of-way and shall not have a low point within the shoulder break line. The driveway's slope between the shoulder break line and roadway edge shall be the same as the slope of the shoulder.
