

Saluda County Spay/Neuter Program Scheduling Requirements

- **YOU MUST BE A SALUDA COUNTY RESIDENT TO USE THIS SERVICE**

- **LIMIT of 2 pets per household per month**
- **All paperwork is due at the time of scheduling.**
 - You must schedule in our office: **175 Public Safety Dr, Saluda, SC 29138**
- **Full payment is due at the time of scheduling.**
 - Surgery is \$20 per cat, \$30 per dog
 - Payment must be cash or check. **CARD PAYMENTS ARE NOT ACCEPTED.**
 - Fees are non-refundable if your appointment is not canceled or rescheduled by 5pm the Thursday prior to surgery.
- **Current rabies certificate must be presented at the time of scheduling.**
 - If you do not show proof of rabies vaccine at the time of scheduling, your pet will be required to receive a rabies vaccine at Pawmetto Lifeline on the day of surgery. Rabies vaccines are \$6 per pet. ***Rabies tags are not accepted as proof of vaccination.***
- **If your pet is 7 years old or older, you will need to have a senior blood panel completed prior to scheduling.**
 - You will need to present those results at the time of scheduling.
- **Pets are required to be in carriers for transport.**
 - Cats must be in hard, plastic carriers when they arrive for transport. If you need to borrow a carrier from Saluda County Animal Control, please let us know that at the time of scheduling. **Please line cat carriers with a puppy pee pad.** (If you need a puppy pad, we will give you one at the time of scheduling)
 - Dogs should be in a hard, plastic carrier. If you must use a wire crate, please bring a sheet to cover the crate for transport. If you need to borrow a carrier, please let us know at the time of scheduling.
 - **One pet per carrier**
- **Feral cats must be in a size appropriate trap for transport.**
 - No feral cats in regular carriers
 - **One feral cat per trap**
